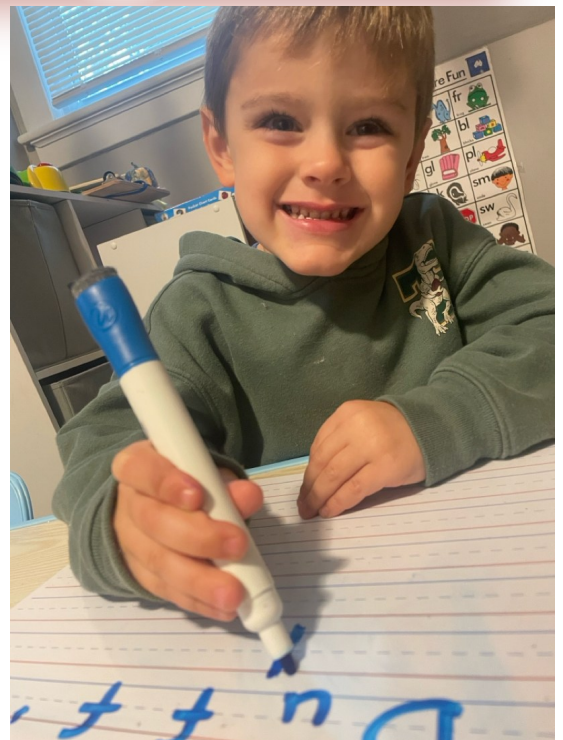




Monacan Indian Nation Childcare & Development Program

Updates

- We are currently serving eleven families and twenty-one children that are attending seven different licensed center-based childcare programs.
- The Monacan Indian Nation Childcare and Development Program is currently at capacity until further notice. Families are welcome to apply but will be placed on a waitlist.
- The childcare program is in the process of bringing aboard Family/In-Home childcare providers.
- Jason (Childcare Development Manager) continued to attend monthly meetings with Region Ready as a member of the Family Council. The Family Council is used to strengthen the individuals and organizations caring for and educating children ages birth to five.
- Supply/sanitation distribution boxes were purchased and delivered to all seven of our partnered childcare providers.
- Jason completed Virginia Preservice Trainings for All Child Care Staff: Foundations for Health and Safety. Jason learned about Early Learning and Development Standards also known as the ELDS. These standards are designed to help individuals who are involved in childcare understand child development.
- The Monacan Indian Nation childcare and development programs brochure was revised and updated for 2025-2026.
- Jason provided a meaningful reading on Native American Culture to children at the Altavista Area YMCA's childcare program for the grand opening of their new library.
